## **Why is documentary photography the mode of choice in South Africa? Discussing strategies towards a photography after documentary.**

The discussion will be followed by a screening of past work and projects.

**Khwezi Gule** is the contemporary collections curator at the Johannesburg Art Gallery. He initiated the formation of *Third Eye Vision*, the first black artist's collective in Durban, South Africa, and in 2004 he worked as a curatorial fellow with the Brett Kebble Art Awards. Khwezi Gule has contributed essays to a number of books, catalogues and publications, and holds a B.Tech degree in Fine Art.

**John Fleetwood** has been the Head of the Market Photo Workshop since 2002. He was born in Johannesburg in 1970, and completed studies in Political Studies (University of Johannesburg) and Photography (Vaal University of Technology). In 2003 he curated *Urban Life* at the Johannesburg Art Gallery, and in 2004 he convened the Johannesburg *Pan African Photo Encounters*.

**Mikhael Subotzky** is an award winning photographer, his work has been exhibited in major galleries across the world, and is included in the collections of the Museum of Modern Art in New York, the South African National Gallery in Cape Town, and the Johannesburg Art Gallery. He has won numerous accolades, including the 2008 ICP Infinity Award (Young Photographer) and the KLM Paul Huf Award in 2007. He was born in Cape Town in 1981.

**Simangele Kalisa** was born in 1981 in Soweto, Johannesburg, and is currently completing a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of South Africa. She has also completed numerous courses at the Market Photo Workshop, and her work has formed part of various group exhibitions. Simangele was recently awarded the 2009 Tierney Fellowship at the Market Photo Workshop, which will culminate in a solo exhibition at The Photo Workshop Gallery in 2010.
